All participants must be a minimum of 9 years of age for the 5km fun run, 14 years of age for the 10km R/W and 16 years of age for the 21.1km. Proof of age may be required. A junior must be 19 years of age and younger on the 31 December in the year of competition. Participants must wear their correct club colours and official 2026 licence number on the front and back of their vest/crop top. The race number must be worn on the front of the vest crop top covering the numbers of the permanent licence, the province, year and ASA sponsor uncovered. Licence numbers are not permitted to be worn on shorts. Unlicensed runners must wear a temporary licence number on the back of their vest/crop top with the race number on the front. Temporary license runners to wear plain colour vest with no branding to qualify for age category prize, new ASA/KZNA age tags must be worn on the front and back of the vest/crop top. All walkers to wear new asa/kzna walker tag, front and back of their vest/crop top. Walkers without tags will not be considered for prizes. Foreign athletes must adhere to WA Rule CR 1.7, TR 4.1, TR 4.2 together with ASA Rule 9 Tog bag facilities will be available at own risk. Officials, referees and marshals must be obeyed at all times
